

Range Rules & Membership Information for 2023

Membership Rules:

- A sign is posted also explaining the rules at the Range.
- Gate to the range needs to be closed and locked when leaving the site if you are the last one out. This applies during daylight hours and just not at sunset.
- Shooters are encouraged to bring their own target stands when shooting on the pistol ranges. If you bring cardboard boxes, take them home when finished shooting and DO NOT leave them at the range.
- Pick up all brass when done shooting and deposit in trash receptacles.
- Keep vehicles on asphalt paved access roads and parking areas.
- Do not shoot reactive pistol target and steel plates with anything other than 22 caliber rim fire rifles or pistols.

Persons over Age 18:

Must have a current club membership card when using club facilities.

Exception: A member may bring a spouse or significant other as a guest. Any individual under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a paid member over the age of 18.

Persons under 18 years:

Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a paid member over the age of 18. Closures: Ranges may be closed periodically for law enforcement agency training, qualifications and other special events. Range closures are normally posted the club's Facebook page Spearfish Rifle & Trap Club, Inc. or on the bulletin board near to the entrance to the rifle and pistol range.
